- Three people turned up for the Village Tidy up (2025) four turned up in 2026
- Edward Watson and I attended the Planning Advisory Service review of East Suffolk Planning Dept, with particular reference to the Wilderness Reserve Application
- Due to lack of interest it was decided to not progress with a Neighbourhood Plan
- The steps up to the Millenium Green were repaired
- An additional noticeboard has been installed at The Hub
- Village Gateways have been installed
- The ditch at the top of Brick Kiln Lane has been cleared out and piped
- Water, Electricity and WIFI have been installed on The Millenium Green
- The tree overhanging the bottom of Brick Kiln Lane has been felled.
- The community is getting better at reporting pot holes leading to a better repair record.
- A donation post has been installed at the entrance of The Hub carpark
